The Glass Menagerie

by Tennessee Williams
directed by Karen Wakeham

A delicate, moving and beautifully-written play, 'The Glass Menagerie' is recognised as a reflection of Tennessee Williams' own early life. Tom, a young writer, struggles to cast off the suffocating burden of supporting his mother Amanda and reclusive sister Laura during the late 1930s. With the best intentions, Tom introduces Laura to a 'gentleman caller', but all goes badly awry.

Since premiering in 1944, the play has enjoyed numerous successful productions over the years—on the professional stage, on radio, on TV and on film, including Indian and other language adaptations. The Glass Menagerie is truly a seminal classic of enduring appeal.

Little Murders is a pitch-black comedy about an everyday dysfunctional family, the Newquists, trying to survive in the urban jungle of late 1960s New York – a city where random shootings, garbage strikes, air pollution, power failures and offensive phone calls are the norm. When daughter Patsy brings Alfred, her new boyfriend, home to this embattled household to introduce him to the family, his passivity in the face of danger only increases the conflict - and the comedy.

Winner of the Obie and Outer Critics Circle awards, 'Little Murders' resonates as powerfully today as at its premiere in 1967. *

'Amadeus' is a scintillating fictional account of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and Antonio Salieri, his contemporary composer. The play focuses on Salieri who, tormented by jealousy and intense dislike of Mozart, plots his downfall. Salieri believes Mozart's music to be truly divine but cannot fathom why God has favoured such a vulgar creature to be His creative instrument.

This superb 18th century costume drama won the 1981 Tony Award for Best Play and the 1984 film version won eight Academy Awards, including Best Film. Be sure not to miss this stunning theatrical event. *
