So begins a penetrating examination of how men struggle to deliver justice in a world where prejudice, racism and privilege hold such strong sway, often below the surface.

First written in 1954, this powerful drama continues to enthral audiences 70 years later. Its themes are just as pertinent in our world today. \*

Widely considered one of the greatest American plays, *A Streetcar Named Desire* won the Pulitzer Prize for Drama and the New York Drama Critics' Circle Best Play in 1948. The 1951 film adaptation starring Marlon Brando and Vivien Leigh won four Academy Awards and is regarded as an American classic. \*
