The Ladykillers is a classic black comedy. Based on the popular 1955 Ealing film of the same name, it was adapted in 2011 by Graham Linehan and found immediate success.

Posing as amateur musicians, Professor Marcus and his gang of criminal misfits rent rooms in the lopsided house of sweet but strict Mrs Wilberforce in order to pull off a brilliantly conceived heist job. The police are clueless but Mrs Wilberforce soon becomes wise to their ruse and with only her parrot, General Gordon, to help her, she finds herself alone with five desperate men. But who will be forced to face the music? *
